You may have noticed that we have a new door lock system that was recently installed. We want to reassure you that nothing has happened to cause this new system to be put in place it is just another added level of security for our children and staff.

The exterior doors are locked daily from 9:00am - 2:45pm so when you arrive at school during those times you will need to press the call button on the box located outside the main door which will ring to the office staff. Please note that this call box also has a camera attached so that the main office can see who is entering the building. Please stand in front of the call box until you hear the door unlock.

Thank you for your patience as we all learn this new system.

Reminder that if your child is going to be late or absent to school please call the school office at 353-9333 by 9:00am. This really helps us to make sure that all of our students are safe either here at school or at home.
