July 10-July 14 from 9:15am - 2:15pm

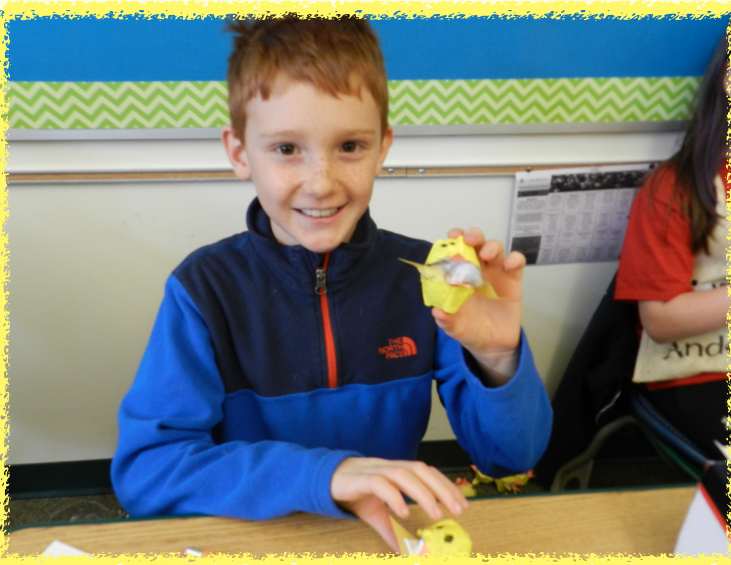
