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

Dear Lacrosse Parents and Players:

As the sport of lacrosse has grown, so too have local, state and national rules governing the sport. There is a National Federation rule that we need to make you aware of. By Federation rule, all *HIGH SCHOOL BOYS* lacrosse team helmets must be of the same color and all helmet decals must be school issued.

We bring this to your attention now so that you can plan accordingly when purchasing new equipment. This rule change mandating the color of helmets is for <u>HIGH SCHOOL</u> **PLAYERS ONLY**. However, it may impact how you plan equipment purchases as a <u>middle</u> school participant.

The Cascade "CPV-R" or the "CPX-R" Lacrosse Helmet' are the official helmets for Freeport High School Lacrosse. It will be mandatory for every *HIGH SCHOOL PLAYER* to have one of these helmets or something similar approved by the coaching staff. Both custom helmets will have a maroon helmet, white visor, white chin guard and a black mask. Over the years, the CPV-R has morphed into more of a youth & high school helmet, and the CPX-R, more of a high school and college helmet. You can view these helmets at: cascadelacrosse.com

These helmets were selected because of safety ratings, availability, and believe it or not, its comparatively affordable price. This helmets retails between \$140.00-\$230.00 in most stores. Through a sporting goods dealer that the school works with on a regular basis, we are able to secure a group price of CPV-R \$114.50 & CPX-R \$160.50 and pass this savings on to you. If you would like to take advantage of this school pricing offer, please fill out the enclosed order form and return it to the high school athletic office no later than **Friday, March 22nd**.
