### **DURHAM COMMUNITY SCHOOL PTA – Call for Donations**

As many of you already know, our Durham PTA funds about \$12,000 worth of enrichment activities for our kids each year. These activities include field trips, grant requests for items teachers need in their classrooms, art and P.E. supplies, and instruments for the school.

We are holding a basket raffle to help raise some of the funds needed for these programs. The Raffle will be held during Treat Street which occurs on October 27th, 2018 from 3pm to 5pm (you do not need to be present to win).

#### **What are we looking for?**

We are looking for donations of items that can be incorporated into the theme for your child's grade level. The donations should be something a child of that age would enjoy or a gift card for a place or event your child would enjoy.

**Preschool** – Arts and Crafts (coloring books, paints, crayons, clay, paint brushes etc.)

**Kindergarten** – Snow Days (snacks, books, games, snowball makers, etc.)

**1st grade** – Yard games (Frisbees, soccer balls, footballs, jump ropes, chalks, etc.)

**2nd grade** – Family Game Night (Legos, board games, card games etc.)

**3rd grade** – Baking/Cooking (pans, spoons, cookbooks, ingredients, baking cups, decorations etc.)

**4th grade** – Movie night (movie passes, popcorn, DVD's, travel pillows, etc.)

**5th - 8th grade** – Gift Cards (Starbucks, Hannaford, Home Depot, Target, basically anywhere.)

If you would like to donate an item, please have it delivered to your child's classroom by the end of day on **October 19th, 2018**. This will allow us to put the baskets together for Treat Street and get them displayed for the raffle.
